He has an internal system - Applications  
for reservations - Passengers, buses, speakers  
and attendees. Will bring people to  
the park.

Passing through a road.

Wants to close down the park ahead  
of time.

It's a big park that could accommodate  
more than 100-600 in May.

We explained it looked like there would  
be more than 1,000, more than 600  
on Facebook.

Like Baker, 3%, 1,500

The fact moving the rally would be  
an infringement of his first amendment  
rights.

People are not going to accept  
a change of venue.

Level of expectation for evidence -

1776 Rally in Texas - Patriot Group

Berkeley police allowed people to fight.

Rhetoric from PATRIOT and other groups

Was not heard a specific threat.

Peaceful demonstration.

This group is not threatening the  
businesses and residents.

Water spigot - accessibility

He has never said anything about  
1,000 - 2,000 people
